Dear Senator Valesky:

SEIU Local 200United endorses a voting system for NYS which incorporates paper ballots counted by hand or by precinct-based optical scanners. Each polling place would have at least one ballot marking device for disabled voters and voters whose first language is not English. We oppose touch screen voting machines (DREs) even if they have a paper component because they are still vulnerable to software error and fraud. A computer can be programmed in such a way that the paper component shows a different vote than what is actually being counted inside the "black box."

In addition, touch screen voting machines are more expensive than paper ballot systems.

Further, they take meaningful voting oversight out of the hands of poll workers and election commissioners (since most are not computer experts) and put it in the hands of vendors and technicians from computer companies.

We urge our members to exercise their democratic right and responsibility to vote. How can our members take voting seriously if the type of voting equipment can be so easily manipulated to change votes?

Please let me know whether you will support paper ballots counted by hand or by precinct-based optical scanners (along with a ballot marking machine for those who need it). I look forward to your reply.
